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ABSTRACT

"Technological innovations and digitization of resources have changed the traditional forms of library systems. Though these methods are eliminating the need for traditional structures, there is also an argument for the need of physical interaction with books and peers in the library. There still exists a strong support for books in the traditional form and the need for the 'joy of reading'." Libraries need to be transformed as an active social space. A public library is just not a space to access physical and digital data but also create an environment to initiate interaction of people and exchange of ideas takes place among all people of diverse backgrounds and age groups visiting the library.
